Our seven-year-old girl is in her bedroom having a tea party with her stuffed/plastic animal toys. She's about to drop some good news:

Girl: Good news: As you might've heard (from monkey)

We cut to the pack-shots.

Girl: PG Tips/Lyons Tea removed the plastic wrapper,

So they are now totally plant based:

Back to her.

Girl: I'm ditching ALL the plastic I can! All of it!

We see all of her toys, some which are obviously made of PLASTIC, sitting around the table. She goes to comfort them...

Girl: I don't mean you, guys.

Just before sipping on her cuppa, she adds a low...

Girl: ...for now.

We see a pack of PG tips. On screen, we can read:

LOGO: PG tips.

SUPER: Now (fully) biodegradable.

Tea Party – Extended version

A seven-year-old girl is in her bedroom having a tea party with her stuffed animal toys. She's not the stereotypical little girl, but a wildlife fan with paintings of animals and nature hanging on the walls. We hear a playful march rhythm. Once everyone has its cuppa ready, she starts her speech:

Girl: Alright, everyone, I want to address the elephant in the room. No, not you, Lola.

She addresses the stuffed elephant sitting in one of the chairs. She points at the PG tips box on the table.

Girl: The tea! We're switching to PG Tips now. These tea bags are "bio...degradable. Thanks, Monkey...

She takes a look at everyone, before continuing.

Girl: While some... STILL use PLASTIC! Did you know that?

She takes a pause, and we see all the stuffed animals sitting around the table... in silence. We see a stuffed shark with its mouth open.

Girl: I know. I would be speechless, too...

Girl: They are made of polyp... polypropylene ...
